- Black matt powder coated aluminium
- Slim aluminium sightlines
- Roller ball door catch with fixed handle
- 8mm toughened single glazing
- Suitable for residential and light commercial
- Discreet door stop to the top of all opening doors



Internal Steel Look Door Dimensions

- Single Door Frame up to 1000mm wide x 2600mm high
- Double Door Frame up to 2000mm wide x 2600mm high
- Frame depth front to back 30mm
- Double doors interlock sightline 93mm

- U-Value of 1.4 W/m²K

- Laminated triple glazing – clear or satin
- Safety cylinder with 5 keys
- Concealed GEZE door closer
- RC3 security
- U-Value of 0.76 W/m²K
- Drop down weatherseal
- 1.5mm aluminium skin
- Maximum door height 2500mm

Optional Extras for Glass Pivot Doors and Hybrid Pivot Doors (not included in standard specification):

- Laminated triple glazed side panel - clear or satin
- Triple glazed top light – clear or satin
- Wood effect or designer colour/finish e.g. Dark Concrete or Oak per side

- Safety cylinder with 5 keys
- Concealed GEZE door closer
- Drop down weatherseal
- 3mm aluminium skin
- Maximum door height 3000mm

Art Deco and Bauhaus are complimentary styles of product design that flourished across the world in the 1920s and 1930s. These movements have influenced the design of buildings, bridges, ocean liners, furniture, and everyday objects like the wireless and vacuum cleaners.

Art Deco got its name from the 1925 International Exhibition of Modern Decorative and Industrial Arts in Paris. Art Deco combined modern styles with fine craftsmanship and rich materials. During its heyday, it represented luxury, glamour, exuberance and faith in social and technological progress. The Empire State Building, Chrysler Building, and other skyscrapers of New York City built during the 1920s and 1930s are monuments to the style. At that 1925 Exposition, architect Le Corbusier wrote that practical objects such as furniture (or windows) should not have any decoration at all; his conclusion was that "Modern decoration has no decoration"

The Bauhaus architectural movement seamlessly dovetails with Art Deco, because it champions synthesized fine arts, crafts, design, architecture and technology. Promoting rational, functional design that embraces a 'form follows function', 'less is more ethos', born in the immediate aftermath of WW1.
